Dear Friends,

It is amazing to think that the Nambale Magnet School has just completed its fourth full year of operation. What began in January of 2009 with a "pioneer" class of 32 youngsters has now blossomed into an active residential campus with over 180 students from prenursery through fourth grade. Over the past four years, the School has made momentous strides in establishing itself as one of the most successful primary schools in Western Kenya.

In addition to the excellent education that the children are receiving, the School has become a source of civic pride and inspiration for all the residents of this quite poverty-stricken rural region. A number of local residents have found employment at the School as gardeners, launderers, security guards, food service employees and livestock herders. Indeed, the School is more than exceeding its founder's (Rev. Evalyn Wakhusama) goal to serve as "a beacon of hope and a symbol of development" for the people of Nambale.

The School has also progressed significantly on the path to self- sufficiency. The children now enjoy a diet that includes vegetables grown in their own gardens and greenhouse, milk from the dairy unit, fresh eggs from the poultry unit, and tilapia from the fish pond, all of which are maintained on site. And, while much of the surrounding region struggled through a recent drought, the School had an ample water supply, thanks in large part to the rooftop water catchment system that feeds two large cisterns, where rainwater can be purified and provided to the children for drinking, cooking and bathing.

All of these wonderful developments are the product of your generosity and thoughtfulness. Our charitable organization, WIKS-USA, Inc., recognizes that, without donors such as you, the children of Nambale would be subsisting in the same state of destitute poverty and hopelessness that plagued the region before the School was opened.

As stewards of your gifts, it is important to us to ensure that they are used in the best possible way at the School. We are pleased that our Kenyan partners at the School share this belief, and appreciate the importance of transparency and accountability in the use of financial resources.
